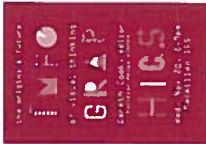
OUR MISSION

Co-sponsor Science Communication Series events with Brown Science Center, Science Underground, STEAM, and The Triple Helix.

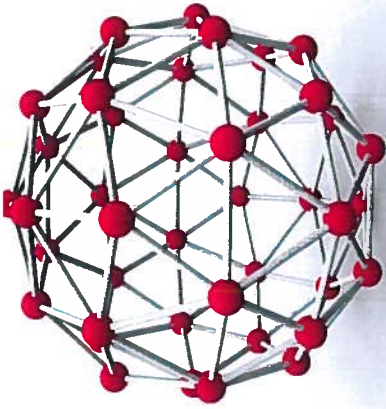
