F. John Case is currently the Senior Vice President for Operations and CFO at the Morehouse School of Medicine in Atlanta, Georgia. He held similar positions at the University of Akron, the Cleveland Clinic, and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. His education includes an Ed.D., Higher Education Management, University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, PA; MBA, St. John Fisher College, Rochester, NY; BS, Finance and Accounting, State University of New York (SUNY) at Geneseo.
